

Application to Renew Registration

Registration may be renewed by the person registered as the owner at anytime prior to the date of its expiry using this form, provided the details on the Certificate of Registry have not changed and any change of address on the Register has been or is notified. The registration of the ship will be renewed for a further period of five years from the date of

expiry and a new Certificate of Registry, bearing the same registration number, will be issued.

If changes have occurred to the details included on the Certificate of Registry or the registration has expired, application to re-register the ship must be made on the separate form "Application to Register a Small Ship" available from the Ships' Registry.
